Funding Conditions. To be considered for funding from Broadacres' Community Development Fund, all applications should meet the following criteria:

- 1. Broadacres must own housing in the parish/town of the project.
- 2. The maximum funding contribution from Broadacres will be no more than ± 500 .
- 3. Where the total project cost is £500 or less there is discretion to award the full cost. Where the total project cost is above £500 up to 75% can be awarded up to a maximum of £500.
- 4. All requests for funding must be in writing using the Broadacres pro-forma.
- 5. Organisations applying for funding and/or benefiting from funding should either be registered charities or operate on a not-for-profit or voluntary basis.
- 6. Projects should promote or deliver activities which directly benefit local communities. These may be in the areas of housing, training, education, environmental improvements, safety and security, recreation and leisure, arts and cultural activities or childcare.
- 7. Funding will not be made available to organisations/groups whose mainstream funding is from Central Government departments.
- 8. Where applicable, successful applicants must provide documentary evidence of match funding secured <u>prior</u> to the grant from Broadacres being released.
- 9. In kind match will be accepted in the form of donated equipment or services, or volunteer hours towards the project. The applicant must be able to outline what the in-kind match equates to as part of the total cost of the project within the application. The successful applicant must provide documentary evidence of the in-kind match within the completed Broadacres grant monitoring form.
- 10. Within 12 months of the funding being allocated,
 - a) the project will be completed,
 - b) our Grant Monitoring Form with proof of expenditure will be completed and returned to Broadacres Community Involvement Team,
 - c) failure to return this may result in future applications from the group / project being declined.
 - d) we may request the funding to be returned if funds are unspent.
- 11. Broadacres have the right to any positive publicity resulting from the funding.
- 12. We are unable to hold over projects from year to year but re-applications can be made.
- 13. An organisation or project can only apply to the fund once a year.
- 14. Priority for awards is given to projects and organisations that have not applied before or that have not received an award in the previous three years.
